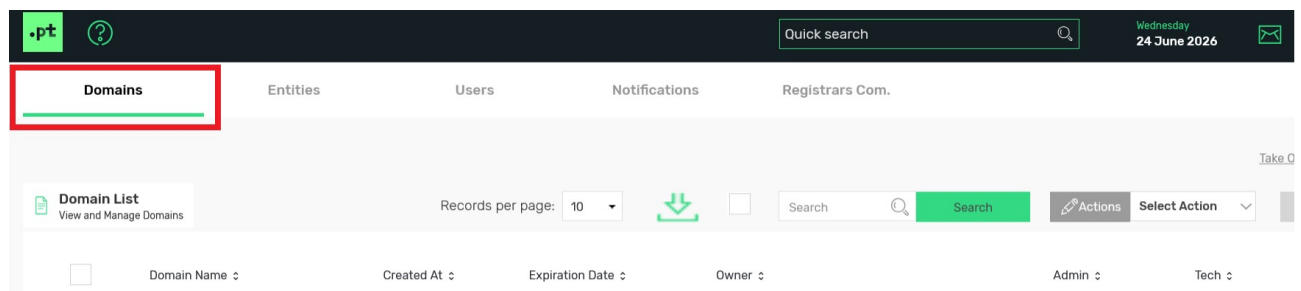


## How do I change the ownership of my .PT domain name?

To change your domain ownership online, you need to:

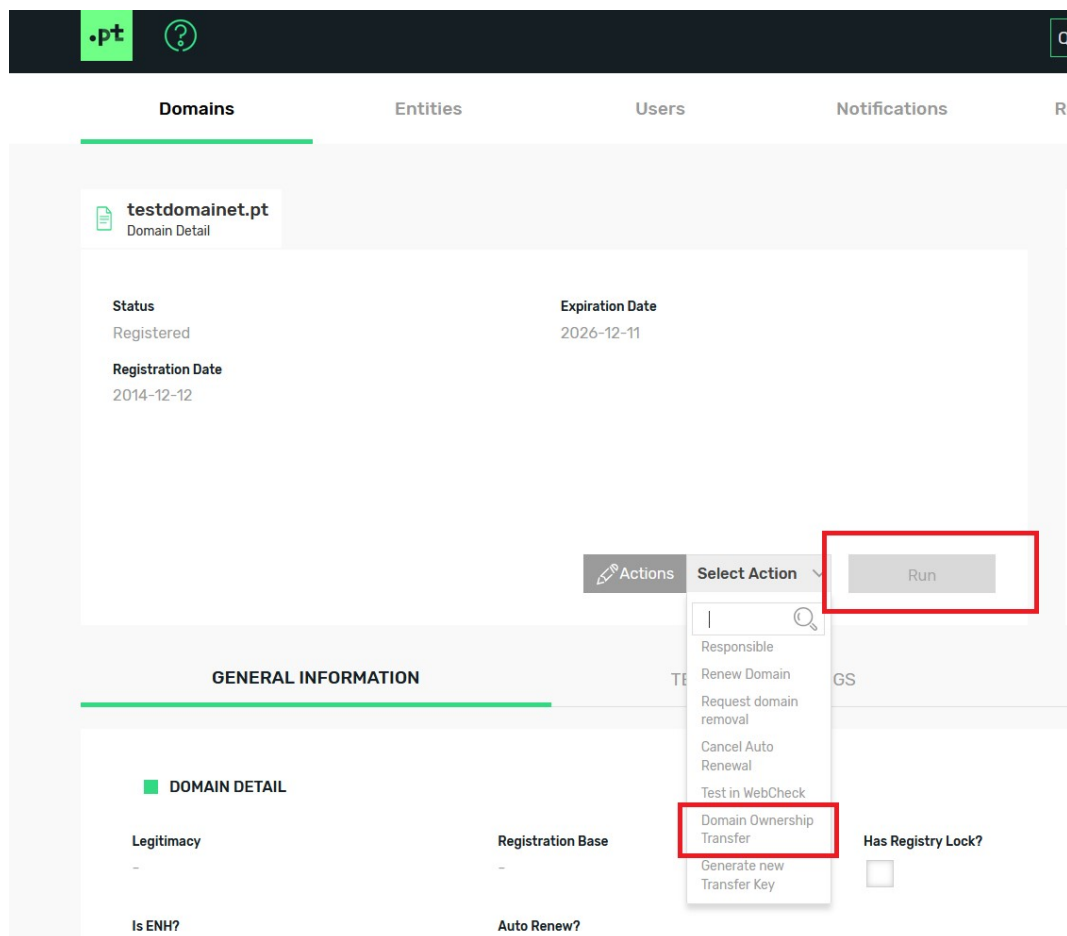
1. Access your **Reserved Area** at <https://registo.pt.pt/Login.aspx>  
(there is a link to retrieve password on the site, if forgotten)

2. Select the "**Domains**" tab;



3. **Choose the domain** for which you want to change ownership;

4. Select the "**Domain Ownership Transfer**" action and click "**Run**";



5. Select the new owner by clicking “**Select Entity**”, and entering their NIC handle (if available) or their country code and ID number (NIF number, if residing in Portugal).

6. Once the new owner is assigned, click **Transfer**, and then **Confirm**.

7. The new owner will receive a notification, having 8 days to accept the transfer of ownership, through the link received;

8. The new owner must read and accept the Registry’s Declaration of Responsibility and Processing of Costumer Personal Data policies;

9. The old and new owners will both receive emails confirming the success of the change.

Instead, you can also request this change directly from PT.PT, with the authorization of the domain owner which can be expressed by filling out and sending the ownership transfer draft available [here \(legal person\)](#) or [here \(natural person\)](#).
